Happy Friday! Here is today's news:

1. Pool season is in full swing! Many of you and your families are enjoying the pool and while most are very respectful of our facilities, there have been some issues. Following are the **pool rules** as a reminder for you. Please make sure your guests are aware of the rules prior to visiting the facility. Two items to take special note of are the requirement for **children to wear SWIM DIAPERS and that NO SMOKING** is allowed in the pool area. A cigar stub was found in the pool area this morning and cigarette butts are found on a regular basis. Please smoke outside the pool fence confines and dispose of butts in the ash urns provided by the east and west clubhouse doors. Swim Diapers are made to provide safe and leak proof barriers for your child to be in the pool. Regular diapers allow leakage and cause contamination of the pool.

POOL RULES

Parents and Guardians are responsible for adherence to the following rules. Homeowners are responsible for the actions of their family, residents, tenants and guests

OPEN 5 A.M. TO MIDNIGHT CLOSED MIDNIGHT TO 5 A.M. SECURITY CARDS WILL NOT WORK FROM MIDNIGHT TO 5 A.M.

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY!
BATHERS SHOULD NOT SWIM ALONE
Use Pool/Spa at your own risk
Keep gate closed at all times

- PERSONS AGE 18 OR YOUNGER MUST BE ACCOMPANIED AND SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT RESIDENT AT ALL TIMES
- Elderly persons and those suffering from heart disease, diabetes or high blood pressure should consult a physician before using the spa or pool
- A person who has or has had diarrhea within the last two weeks caused by an unknown source or from any communicable or fecal borne disease may not enter the pool or spa

- Persons having skin abrasions, cuts, blisters or any communicable disease transmissible by water may not enter the pool or spa.
- Persons using prescription medications should consult a physician before using the spa or pool
- Any child under three years old, any child not toilet trained, and anyone who lacks control of defecation shall wear a water resistant swim diaper and waterproof swimwear. Swim diapers and waterproof swimwear shall have waist and leg openings fitted such that they are in contact with the waist or leg around entire circumference
- Persons under the influence of alcohol or other impairing chemical substances are not permitted to enter the pool/spa area
- Smoking is prohibited in the pool/spa area
- Swimming attire only is permitted in the pool and spa. Cutoffs, jeans,
 shorts or street wear are strictly prohibited
- Radios and other audio equipment must be used with ear phones or head phones only
- Pool furniture is never allowed in the pool or spa and at no time is the clubhouse furniture to be moved and used in or around the pool and spa area
- Cooking of any kind is not allowed in the pool and spa area. No glass containers, plates, sharp objects, etc. are allowed in the pool area at any time
- Running or engaging in unsafe activities or horseplay in or around the pool or spa is prohibited
- Towels and clothing are not permitted to be hung on the fence
- The use of mattresses, float or other flotation devices are allowed only when their use does not interfere with others occupying the pool
- No pets are allowed in the pool and spa area with the exception of a service animal assisting it's owner
- Each household shall limit the number of people in the pool and spa area to 6

VIOLATION OF THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN LOSS OF PRIVILEGES AND/OR FINES

- 2. Two residents have reported **rattle snake encounters o**n their property. One was in a cactus cluster on 2500 W and the other was on a driveway on 750 N. No one was harmed in either encounter, but please be aware the snakes are out. We have several harmless varieties, but rattlesnakes are also present from time to time.
- 3. To my knowledge everyone has now complied with having their palm tree fronds trimmed. However, some of you wanted to give your trees some time to see if they would sprout new growth once the temperatures warmed up for a few weeks. We have been in the 90's and even reached 100 a few times already. If your tree does not have any green sprouting, it is really unlikely that a miracle is going to occur. If you are one of those with a palm trunk standing with no growth, please have those removed no later than July 1st. If you need assistance with removal, let me know and I will be happy to give you the name and phone number of a tree service.
- 4. A couple of residents have asked me to remind everyone to be cautious when you are on 2500 W (Stoneridge Drive) as you approach the **golf cart crossing area**. It can be very difficult to see around cars in driveways and you can be on top of a golf cart before you know it. Please slow down and take extra caution on all of our streets and particularly the two areas where golfers are crossing.
